JOHANSEN IAS PROVIDER REGISTRATION AGREEMENT

1. THE MUSIC

- 1.1 Johansen Individual Auditory Stimulation (Johansen IAS) uses music created by Rotna Music (The Music).
- 1.2 The Music is fundamental to Johansen IAS and no other music is used and if other music is used it is not a Johansen IAS programme and cannot be described as such.
- 1.3 The Music will be customised to a specific client's needs (either by the choice of The Music or by customisation of The Music) and each client, or in the case of a Johansen Alpha programme each school, will be provided with a recording or recordings of The Music (Recording) which can only be used for that client or school.
- 1.4 The Recording may be provided on a CD or digitally but in any case, is not transferrable and must only be used with the client or school it has been designed for. The Recording must not be copied.
- 1.5 The Recording may be provided by any Johansen IAS National Director or any person authorised by the National Director.
- 1.6 In the UK & Ireland is the National Director and is authorised by the JIAS International Directors to make the Recordings.
- 1.7 The Music is copyright and CNS will pay the royalties to Rotna Music. The Provider will not make recordings or alter the Recording in any way.

2.0 THE CLINICAL DECISIONS

- 2.1 The Provider is the only person who will have direct contact with the client, and it is up to The Provider to obtain all the relevant information and decide whether or not Johansen IAS is appropriate and if so the type of Recording they require.
- 2.2 This will often be based on an Audiogram, but other clinical information will be relevant as well.
- 2.3 In order to maintain the standard of the Johansen IAS programme when ordering Recordings from CNS it is requested that this information is given to CNS who may discuss the choice of Recording or the clinical decision with The Provider and International Directors if appropriate. CNS will also generally be happy to discuss cases with The Provider, during courses and suggest possible Recordings or other actions but as CNS has not assessed the client the final decision of choice of Recording and customisation required or other course of action will remain with The Provider.
- 2.4 At all times The Provider will remain solely responsible for all clinical decisions made in respect of their clients. The Provider is also solely responsible for the supervision of the Johansen IAS programme with their clients and making sure that their client is using the programme properly and in a safe and appropriate manner and that any problems are resolved.

3.0 INDEMNITY FOR LOSSES AND INSURANCE

- 3.1 The Provider is an independent practitioner and is not under the supervision of CNS.
- 3.2 The Provider confirms by signing this Registration Agreement that they have adequate Professional Indemnity Insurance and undertake to keep this cover in place.
- 3.3 So far as the law allows The Provider will indemnify CNS for claims and all losses including any indirect, special or consequential loss of The Provider or their client and for any such claims of whatsoever nature made by any such clients or any other person advised by The Provider.

4.0 TRAINING

- 4.1 Training of Johansen IAS is regulated by Johansen IAS international standards and only CNS and authorised individuals are allowed to train others in Johansen IAS and Johansen Alpha in the UK and Ireland.
- 4.2 The Johansen IAS Provider Training Course is only intended to train The Provider to implement Johansen IAS programmes for individuals and Johansen Alpha in schools and The Provider may not train anyone else as a Provider of Johansen IAS or Johansen Alpha programmes.

5.0 UPDATES

5.1 It is The Provider's responsibility to keep up to date on developments in the Johansen IAS programmes. The Provider is required to attend an update at least every 3 years.

6.0 DATA PROTECTION

- 6.1 In accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) 2018, CNS will use personal information collected from The Provider for the purposes of
- 1) Support, billing, and other similar activities
 - 2) Keeping The Provider informed about products, services, offers and upcoming events.
- 6.2 In order for CNS to provide The Music, The Provider will also provide personal information on their client. CNS may retain this information and may share it with the JIAS International Directors. The Provider must obtain their client's explicit consent in writing to give the information to CNS and that it may be shared with the JIAS International Directors and advise that it may be retained by CNS as long as CNS requires to do so.
- 6.3 CNS is registered with ICO and responsible for the data protection for JIAS Directors.

TERMINATION OF SUPPLY OF RECORDINGS

CNS reserves the right at her own absolute discretion to not to supply Recordings to The Provider at any time. Recordings may be supplied by other authorised National Directors or Supervisors at their discretion.

7.0 LAW OF ENGLAND

7.1 In the event of any dispute arising, the Law of England will apply to this Agreement and any such dispute, including non-contractual disputes of claims, will be heard in the English Courts.
